The Parish Council continue to strongly object to this application however note that our concern has been addressed regarding the additional window opening proposed for the front elevation has been removed

22/0036/TWR3MJ Coombe Hill Junction, Tewkesbury Road, Coombe Hill, Gloucester, Gloucestershire. Improvements to the existing junction of the A38 and A4019 at Coombe Hill, consisting of the upgrading of the existing left turn lane from the A38 onto the A4019 with a longer signal controlled left turn lane, improved facilities for pedestrians and cyclists, and associated infrastructure.

8.1 Councillor Oldham reported as follows:

Apperley Village Hall:

8.2 Highways: Councillor Pollard to report the large pothole at Lower Apperley, the state of the road at Walton Hill from Manor Cottage to Manor Farm and Sawpit Lane

Snow/Ice in December: The state of the roads in Walton Hill were treacherous with residents not being able to get out of their houses for at least 5 days with no delivery drivers being able to make any drops. Deerhurst was gritted along with the B4213 so why wasn't the road in and out of Deerhurst Walton? **Clerk to email CC Awford.**

8.3 Public Rights of Way: An occupant of Greyhill Farm has been telling walkers that they are not allowed on the track from the B4213 and the paths joining it near the Farm. ADE76, ADE77 and ADE78 are probably involved; and possibly ADE74. Councillor Pollard to contact Hilary Grace at PROW to see if there is anything that can be done.

Councillor Pollard said that he had dealt with a couple of issues.
