1. Apologies: None

2. Minutes - The minutes of meeting held on 25 May 2022 were agreed and signed

3. Matters Arising from last year's Minutes:

Allotment Path: Still problems with Countrywide cutting the paths at the allotments.

Play Area: Grant was received from the GPFA last year.

4. Chairman's Annual Report: The Chairman read out his report.

5. Report from DPPFA: None

6. Matters Raised by Parishioners:

The following matters were raised by the Church Warden, Danny Vince:

Tower Clocks: There are two in the Parish – one at Apperley War Memorial and one at the Church. Clock at War Memorial: Currently trying to raise £23,000 to carry out the necessary repairs – Secured a grant of £4,000, £3,000 of donations to date and currently fund raising.

Clock at Church: Needs a new crutch costing £1800 – the Friends of Deerhurst Church have agreed to take over raising the necessary funds.

Both clocks will require approximately £250 per annum for ongoing maintenance.

Mr Vince asked if the Parish Council would be willing to contribute to the maintenance cost of one of the clocks. It was agreed that the Clerk would put this item on the agenda for the June meeting for further consideration.

Willows by Village Pond: These trees required some maintenance to keep them in good condition and wondered who was responsible for this? A short discussion took place, and it was agreed that the Chairman would look into the ownership question. Put on the June agenda.

Kings Coronation Tree at Village Hall: Highlighted that the tree had been planted over the sewer.

Meeting closed at 7.15pm
